#### What does sufficient protection mean?

## Conservation status of the main areas for harbour porpoises in MPAs is stable and the species has Favourable Conservation Status.

The harbour porpoise, needs protected areas where it can reproduce.

The porpoise's gestation and lactation periods are long – all year around.

Areas used for breeding, resting, foraging, or social behavior, are called core areas.

These areas are important for the survival of the population.

### Hoburgs bank och Midsjöbankarna

- Natura 2000 site in 2016
  - Baltic proper harbour porpoise and seabirds.
- Joint responsibility
- Differences in juristictions

### **Conservation objectives**

- The area should contribute to reaching favourable conservation status for Baltic proper harbour porpoise.
- The area should act as a nursery.
- Food availability should be such that a favourable population is supported.
- Displacement of harbour porpoises does not occur in the area.

2 methods:

- Continuous monitoring with click-detectors at North midsea bank
  - 2013 to present
- Acoustic survey with hydrophone
  - 2022

#### **Fisheries conservation measures in MPAs**

- » High on the political agenda
- » Voluntary committment in UN Oceans Conference
  - Strategic work
  - Platform for fisheries conservation measures in MPAs
  - National fisheries regulation in > 30 MPAs
  - Finalized and ongoing processes within the EU Common Fisheries Policy
- » Infringement case EU concerning harbour porpoise



#### **Fisheries conservation measures – The Process**

Most often based on the request to SwAM from the County Administrative Board responsible for the management of the marine protected area in need of fisheries conservation measures

#### National fisheries legislation

Process: SwAM can issue the regulation

**EU Common Fisheries Policy** 

Process:

- Government assignment to SwAM
- Concerned Member States
- Pre-consultation meeting
- Ad-hoc group meetings and bilateral meetings, negotiations
- Sufficient information
- Joint recommendation sent to the EU Commission
- Scientific evalutation
- Delegated regulation adopted by the EU Commission



#### Water Management Current processes within the EU Common Fisheries Policy related to measures for protecting harbour porpoise

- » Finalized processes Article 11 CFP fisheries conservation measures in marine protected areas
  - Fladen, Lilla Middelgrund, Stora Middelgrund och Röde bank and Morups bank – Kattegatt
- » Finalized processes EU Technical regulation
  - Hoburgs bank och Midsjöbankarna
  - Sydvästskånes utsjövatten

#### **Fisheries conservation measures - examples**

- » Prohibition of net fishery
- » Temporal prohibition of net fishery
- » Temporal obligation to use ADDs (pingers) in net fishery
- » Zones where fishing with hooks, pot fishing and pelagic trawl is allowed
- » No-take zone

- -> Eliminate/minimize by-catch of birds, harbour porpoise or other marine mammals
- -> No physical impact on sea floor
- -> Natural food webs

### Fisheries conservation measures in place since December 2021

- A ban for all net fishing in the area, as well as in the adjacent area Södra Midsjöbanken, outside of the marine protected area.
- A zone with prohibition of all fisheries except hand held gear, pots and traps in the area Norra Midsjöbanken, which is also a HELCOM MPA.
