This side-event addresses several areas of cooperation of high importance for Sweden. The platform has over the years developed mutual benefits from sharing knowledge and sustainable technology.

Impacts of and adaption to climate change on water resources and countermeasures including eutrophication and flooding, makes it clear we need to work with integrated water resource management.

Water is a cross-cutting issue, as is mirrored in the shared responsibility for water issues between different departments and agencies in our countries. Sustainable water management and development must therefore go beyond sectorial solutions.

There is a need for stronger inclusion of sustainable practices such as circular economy across the Water-Energy-Food-Ecosystem (WEFE) nexus and in sustainable consumption and production.
